



# Boarding Checklist

**Help to ensure that your pet's check in goes as smoothly as possible by completing the below checklist prior to drop off.**

- Check dates in confirmation text to ensure your drop off/pick up dates are correct. Call immediately if they are not. (last date listed is the date you intend to pick up)
- We are not able to accept pets with stitches due to risk of infection. Pets showing signs of illness are also not able to be boarded to keep the other animals healthy.
- Send us a copy of your pet's vaccination records as soon as possible. Vaccinations must be in date for the entirety of their stay and should be given at least 10 days prior to drop off. Dogs: Rabies, Distemper/Parvo, Bordetella (Canine Influenza is also HIGHLY Recommended)  
Cats: Rabies, Feline Distemper

We also recommend bringing a copy with you just in case.
- All females over the age of 6 months must be spayed. They must be completely healed from the procedure before boarding with us.
- You may bring beds, blankets, toys (no squeaker toys), and treats (no rawhides) however please be aware that we are not responsible for damage caused to items and you are accepting the risk involved by allowing your pet to have these at unsupervised times. We may also decide not to allow your pet to have certain toys if we believe they could be dangerous. (we do recommend that if your dog is using the budget board option that they have a blanket or bed since these options do not come with the raised cot)
- All food MUST be pre-proportioned in baggies. One bag/ per meal/per pet. This includes "grazers". We cannot accept large bags or containers of food. We are happy to feed raw diets, however we are unable to return containers.**
- Please only bring the amount of medication that will be needed for their stay (may bring a few extra in case of emergency). If they require pill pockets, cheese, or any other treats to take their meds, you will need to provide those (we do have peanut butter). Do not put in food bags if we need to ensure that they have been taken.
- Please have an emergency contact number to give us. This person needs to either be able to reach you if we cannot, or able to pick your dog up in an emergency occurs. Please do not leave your vet's number as an ER contact.
- Ensure that you have read our Liability Waiver/Medical Release prior to signing.
- Drop Off- 6:30am to closing at 7pm. Pick up is 9am. Pick up from 9-1 will incur a half day daycare charge per dog, after 1 will incur a full daycare charge per dog.
- After drop off if you wish to receive daily pictures you must privately message us through Facebook. Once daily we will send pictures to one member of your family. We do not send pictures through email, text, or any other social media platform. You of course are more than welcome to call us to check in during our normal hours of operation from 6:30am-7pm!
- Please help us maintain our No Cancellation Policy by letting us know at least a week before your scheduled drop off date if you need to cancel!
